Killarney Way Park - Dry Well





Hidden beneath the new BBQ pad lays a Dry Well (a.k.a. infiltration chamber or cistern). A dry well is basically a large reservoir where stormwater is stored until it has time to soak into the ground and help recharge our drinking water aquifer.




Install Steps

- 1. Hole dug and water storage vaults placed at the bottom. The pipe beneath the pavers was connected to the vaults.
- 2. Hole then filled with gravel. Water is stored in the open space (voids) between the stones.
- 3. A wall was built on top of the gravel.
- 4. Additional gravel was then filled to the top of the wall.
- 5. Pervious pavers were placed on top of dry well to complete.




Water stored in space between soil/gravel particles
